Who appoints the Governing Body Members?

- Community Governors are appointed by the governing body. They are people who in the opinion of the governing body have the skills required to contribute to the effective governance and success of the school.
- Associate Governors are appointed by the governing body to serve on one or more governing body committee.
- Parent Governors are elected by other parents at the school. They must have a child registered at the school at the time of election but may continue to hold office until the end of their term of office even if their child leaves the school.
- Staff governors are elected by this same category of school staff. They cease to hold office when they cease to be employed at the school.

Voting rights of the Governing Body

- Community and Parent Governors have full voting rights
- Staff Governors have full governing rights, except when it is in relation to the appraisal or pay of school employees
- Associate Governors have no voting rights as they are on the governing body in an advisory capacity, however they may be given a vote on decisions made by a committee they are appointed to.
