JOB DESCRIPTION

Midday Supervisory Assistant

Princes is situated on 4 sites. The main site is on Selborne Street and we have a further site on Old Mill Lane, Picton. We also have 2 satellite units based in Matthew Arnold Primary School, St Anne's Catholic Primary School.

We have vacancies on the Main Site and the Old Mill Lane site. The hours are 8.75/wk, term time only, 11.30am - 1.15pm Monday to Friday, or 11.45am - 1.30pm Monday to Friday depending on the site.

Duties will be as follows:-

- Collecting the food from the kitchen and serving the dinners to the children
- Help the children to eat their lunch
- Work to individual instruction for each child
- Help support good manners during lunch time
- Help to maintain health and safety through this period
- Help the children to be as independent as possible over this period
- Clear the tables and ensure the eating areas/floors are clean and tidy

After lunch:-

- Get coats on and prepare for outdoor play
- Escort children to play
- Help with selected play equipment and supervise children at all times
- Take direction from staff for indoor play if it raining
- Support the children in their play activities and cooperation with each other. It is a valued learning time for our pupils.
- Support children to return to class and prepare for the afternoon sessions
- The post holder may also be asked to return the used crockery and cutlery to the kitchen to be washed

There will be an element of toileting. Full support and training will be provided for the successful applicant.

All applicants will be considered on the basis of suitability for the post regardless of sex, race or disability.
